Summary

The bill mandates state units to purchase algorithmic decision systems that comply with responsible AI standards and updates the definition of unlawful discriminatory practices.

Business Impact

If your organization uses algorithmic decision systems in New York, you must ensure compliance with responsible AI standards by January 1 next year or face legal consequences.

Key Provisions

- State units must purchase algorithmic decision systems that adhere to responsible AI standards.
- Responsible AI standards include minimizing harm, ensuring transparency, and promoting fairness.
- The definition of unlawful discriminatory practice now includes actions taken through algorithmic decision systems.
- The Commissioner of Taxation and Finance is tasked with adopting regulations to enforce these standards.
