## Summary

This bill excludes productions using AI or autonomous vehicles that displace employees from the Empire State film production credit definition.

## Business Impact

If you use AI or autonomous vehicles in film production in New York, you must ensure no employee displacement to qualify for tax credits.

## Key Provisions

- Excludes productions using AI or autonomous vehicles that displace employees from tax credit eligibility.
- Defines 'qualified film' to exclude certain automated productions.
- Targets the film production industry specifically.

## Compliance Checklist

- Ensure no employee displacement occurs when using AI or autonomous vehicles | Who: Film production companies | Penalty: Loss of eligibility for tax credits
- Review production practices involving AI and autonomous vehicles | Who: Film production companies | Penalty: Potential financial impact from tax credit exclusion
