Requires the department of labor to study the long-term impact of artificial intelligence on the state workforce including but not limited to on job performance, productivity, training, education requirements, privacy and security; prohibits any state entity from using artificial intelligence in any way that would displace any natural person from their employment with such state entity until the department's final report is received.

Summary

This bill mandates a study on AI's long-term effects on the workforce and prohibits AI use by state entities that displaces workers within those entities until the report is complete.

Business Impact

If you operate a state entity in New York, you must refrain from using AI that displaces employees until the labor department's report is received.

Key Provisions

- Requires a study on AI's long-term impact on the workforce.
- Prohibits state entities from using AI that displaces workers within those entities until the study is complete.
- Focuses on job performance, productivity, training, education, privacy, and security.
