Summary

This bill mandates that insurance policies in New York include options for applicants to register or decline registration in the Donate Life Registry.

Business Impact

If you use automated decision tools for tenant screening in New York, you must conduct annual impact analyses and notify applicants or face legal action.

Key Provisions

- Insurance policies must include options for Donate Life Registry registration.
- Applies to major medical or similar comprehensive-type coverage.
- Ensures informed decision-making during insurance enrollment.

Compliance Checklist

- Conduct annual disparate impact analysis | Who: Landlords using automated decision tools | Penalty: Investigation by the attorney general for non-compliance
- Make analysis summaries publicly available | Who: Landlords | Penalty: Potential legal action by the attorney general
- Notify applicants about automated decision tools | Who: Landlords | Penalty: Legal action for failure to notify
