Establishes the Uniform Trade Secrets Act in New York, detailing definitions, remedies, and protections for trade secrets.

Business Impact

If you handle trade secrets in New York, you must comply with new protections and remedies by 2026 or face legal consequences.

Key Provisions

- Defines 'misappropriation' and 'trade secret'.
- Provides for injunctive relief and damages for misappropriation.
- Establishes a three-year statute of limitations for claims.
- Allows for attorney's fees in cases of bad faith.
- Preserves secrecy during litigation.
- Displaces conflicting state laws but not contractual or criminal remedies.
