Enacts the New York artificial intelligence bill of rights to provide residents of the state with rights and protections to ensure that any system making decisions without human intervention impacting their lives do so lawfully, properly, and with meaningful oversight.

Summary

The bill establishes an AI Bill of Rights for New York residents, ensuring lawful and effective automated decision-making with oversight, aligning with the White House's AI Blueprint.

Business Impact

If you develop automated systems in New York, you must ensure they are safe and effective or face penalties starting at three times the damages caused.

Key Provisions

- Residents have the right to safe and effective automated systems.
- Protections against algorithmic discrimination are mandated.
- Residents must be informed when automated systems are in use.
- Developers must conduct equity assessments and disparity testing.
- Residents can opt out of automated systems in favor of human alternatives.
- The bill specifies no private cause of action for violations.

Compliance Checklist

- Conduct pre-deployment testing and ongoing monitoring of automated systems. | Who: Developers and operators of automated systems. | Penalty: Liable for penalties starting at three times the damages caused.
- Provide clear explanations of how automated systems impact residents. | Who: Developers and operators of automated systems. | Penalty: Liable for penalties starting at three times the damages caused.
