Summary

The bill establishes the 'advanced artificial intelligence licensing act' to regulate high-risk AI systems, detailing the Department of State's powers and prohibiting certain AI systems.

Business Impact

If you operate high-risk AI systems in New York, you must register and obtain a license or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Requires registration and licensing of high-risk advanced AI systems with specific criteria.
- Establishes an ethical code of conduct for AI operations.
- Creates an advisory council and defines the role of the Secretary of State for oversight and recommendations.
- Defines 'advanced AI system' and 'high-risk AI system' with specific criteria.
- Grants the Department of State authority to issue and revoke licenses, enforce compliance, and impose penalties.
- Prohibits the development and operation of certain harmful AI systems.

Compliance Checklist

- Register and obtain a license for high-risk AI systems | Who: Operators of high-risk AI systems | Penalty: Civil or criminal penalties, including license revocation

- Adhere to the ethical code of conduct established by the act | Who: All operators of advanced AI systems | Penalty: Potential penalties for violations as determined by the Department
