Summary

This bill mandates that owners, licensees, or operators of generative AI systems display a warning about potential inaccuracies and inappropriate outputs on their user interfaces.

Business Impact

If you operate a generative AI system in New York, you must display a user warning about output accuracy or face potential penalties.

Key Provisions

- Requires conspicuous display of warnings on user interfaces of generative AI systems.
- Warnings must inform users about potential inaccuracies and inappropriate outputs.
- Applies to owners, licensees, or operators of generative AI systems.

Compliance Checklist

- Display a warning about output accuracy on the user interface. | Who: Owners, licensees, or operators of generative AI systems. | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance may apply.
