This bill establishes a chief artificial intelligence officer in New York to develop AI policies and coordinate state activities involving AI tools.

Business Impact

If you operate a state agency using AI tools in New York, you must align with the policies set by the chief AI officer once established.

- Establishes the position of chief artificial intelligence officer.
- Mandates development of statewide AI policies and governance.
- Requires coordination among state entities using AI tools.
