HB 1168 aims to enhance transparency in AI systems in Washington State, based on the title and official description only.

Business Impact

If you use AI in Washington, you must disclose system capabilities and limitations by July 1, 2024, or face penalties.

- Addresses AI decision-making processes
- Focuses on transparency in data usage by AI systems
