Summary

This bill mandates that publications in New York disclose any content generated by artificial intelligence or information communication technology.

Business Impact

If you publish content in New York using AI, you must disclose AI-generated sections or face potential penalties.

Key Provisions

- Requires identification of AI-generated content in publications.
- Applies to both printed and electronic media.
- Aims to promote transparency in media consumption.

Compliance Checklist

- Identify and label AI-generated content in publications. | Who: Publishers and editors of newspapers, magazines, and other publications. | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance may apply.
