Requires collection of data by health insurers regarding health insurance claims and decisions made using automated utilization management systems.

## Summary

NJ S1029 requires health insurers to collect data on claims and automated decisions, though specific reporting requirements and penalties are not confirmed.

## Business Impact

If you use automated systems for claims, you must collect data on decisions made.

## Key Provisions

- Health insurers in New Jersey must collect data on claims and automated decisions.
- Specific reporting requirements and penalties are not confirmed without the full bill text.

- Maintain and submit data on health benefit plan claims annually. | Who: Health insurers (payers) | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance not specified.
- Ensure every claim is reviewed by a medical director. | Who: Health insurers (payers) | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance not specified.
- Publicly disclose claim rejection rates on the website. | Who: Health insurers (payers) | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance not specified.
