## Summary

This bill mandates publishers to disclose the use of generative AI in book creation before sale completion.

## Business Impact

If you publish books using generative AI in New York, you must disclose this use before completing sales.

## Key Provisions

- Publishers must disclose the use of generative AI in book creation.
- Applies to all printed and digital books.
- Disclosure must occur before the completion of a sale.
