Requires the collection of oaths of responsible use from users of certain generative or surveillance advanced artificial intelligence systems by the operators of such systems, and transmission of such oaths to the attorney general.

Summary

This bill mandates operators of certain AI systems to collect oaths of responsible use from users, affirmed under penalty of perjury, and submit them to the attorney general.

Business Impact

If you operate generative or surveillance AI systems in New York, you must collect user oaths by 90 days after the law takes effect or face fines.

Key Provisions

- Operators must collect oaths from users of generative or surveillance AI systems.
- Users must affirm responsible use under penalty of perjury, with false statements punishable as a class A misdemeanor.
- Oaths must be submitted to the attorney general within 30 days.
- Operators face fines for failing to collect or submit oaths.
- The attorney general will set rules for oath administration.
- No modifications to the oath are allowed without attorney general approval.

Compliance Checklist

- Collect oaths from users before account creation | Who: Operators of generative or surveillance AI systems | Penalty: Fines of three times the profit from the user or \$3,000 per oath
- Submit collected oaths to the attorney general | Who: Operators of generative or surveillance AI systems | Penalty: Fines for failure to submit oaths
