Summary

This bill mandates a conspicuous warning on generative AI systems to inform users that outputs may be inaccurate or inappropriate.

Business Impact

If you operate a generative AI system in New York, you must display a user warning about potential inaccuracies or face compliance issues.

Key Provisions

- Requires a conspicuous warning on generative AI user interfaces.
- Warning must inform users about potential inaccuracies or inappropriate outputs.
- Applies to owners, licensees, or operators of generative AI systems.

Compliance Checklist

- Display a warning on the user interface of the generative AI system. | Who: Owners, licensees, or operators of generative AI systems. | Penalty: Potential compliance issues.
