## Summary

Prohibits publishing newspapers, magazines, or periodicals produced or edited with AI without significant human oversight in New York.

## Business Impact

If you publish AI-edited content, ensure significant human oversight or face compliance issues after the law takes effect.

## Key Provisions

- Prohibits publication of AI-produced or edited newspapers, magazines, or periodicals without significant human oversight.

## Compliance Checklist

- Ensure significant human oversight in AI-generated content. | Who: Publishers of newspapers, magazines, and periodicals. | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance not specified.
