Prohibits the publication of a digital or physical newspaper, magazine, or periodical which was wholly or partially produced or edited through the use of artificial intelligence without significant human oversight.

Summary

The bill prohibits publishing content wholly or partially produced or edited by AI without significant human oversight.

Business Impact

If you publish newspapers or magazines in New York, you must ensure significant human oversight in AI-generated content by 2024 or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits publication of AI-generated content without significant human oversight.
- Defines 'artificial intelligence' in a comprehensive manner.
- Takes effect sixty days after becoming law.
