## Summary

This bill mandates certification for legal filings created with generative AI, requiring disclosure and human verification of content.

## Business Impact

If you draft legal briefs using generative AI in New York, you must disclose AI use and certify human review or face potential penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Requires certification for legal filings produced using generative AI.
- Mandates disclosure of AI use in the drafting of legal briefs.
- Requires human review and verification of content in AI-generated briefs.
