The bill establishes a Medicaid biometric technology pilot program to enhance identification and prevent fraud, with allocated funding.

Business Impact

If you provide Medicaid services, prepare for biometric ID requirements within 12 months of program approval.

Key Provisions

- §295: Establishes the Medicaid biometric technology pilot program.
- §297: Details the use of biometric technology for identity verification.
- §298: Authorizes the commissioner to promulgate necessary regulations.
- Appropriates \$600,000 for the program.
