Business Impact

If you employ police officers, you must re-assign them during misconduct investigations.

Key Provisions

- Re-assign officers to desk duty if evidence of misconduct exists.
- Conduct preliminary investigations to decide on charges.
- Restore officers to full status if no charges are warranted.
- Maintain desk duty status until charges are resolved.
