Summary

Mandates disclosure and certification of generative AI use in civil filings in New York, with human review verification.

Business Impact

If you use AI for civil filings, you must certify human review or face unspecified consequences.

Key Provisions

- Requires certification of filings produced using generative AI with human review verification.
- Mandates appellant briefs to disclose generative AI use and confirm human review.
