Bill A 8546 requires disclosure of generative AI use in New York civil actions, effective January 1, 2024, with specific conditions and exceptions outlined in the bill.

- Disclosure of generative AI use in civil filings, effective January 1, 2024.
- Exceptions for privileged information and minimal AI use.
