Summary

Bill S 1815 mandates that books created with generative AI disclose this use, applicable to both printed and digital formats.

Business Impact

If you publish books using AI in New York, you must disclose this on the cover 60 days after the law passes.

Key Provisions

- Section 338: Requires disclosure of books created with generative AI.
- Applies to all printed and digital books.

Compliance Checklist

- Include a disclosure of generative AI use in published books | Who: Publishers | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance are unspecified.
