Summary

This bill, titled 'To Create the Criminal Offense of Unlawful Creation or Distribution of Deepfake Visual Material; and to Establish a Cause of Action for Unlawful Creation of Deepfake Visual Material,' proposes to create a criminal offense and a civil cause of action, with specifics pending confirmation from the full bill text.

Business Impact

If you create or distribute visual content in Arkansas, you must ensure it does not involve unlawful deepfakes or face criminal charges.

Key Provisions

- Proposes to establish a criminal offense for unlawful creation or distribution of deepfake visual material, with specific elements pending confirmation from the full text.
- Potential exceptions or defenses will be noted once the full text is available.
- Details on penalties or legal consequences will be provided when available.
- The official description suggests the existence of a civil cause of action for unlawful creation of deepfake visual material, pending confirmation from the full text.

- Ensure that all visual content created or distributed does not involve unlawful deepfakes. | Who: Content creators and media companies. | Penalty: Potential criminal charges.
