Summary

The bill imposes liability for damages caused by chatbots impersonating certain licensed professionals, but specific conditions and penalties are not confirmed.

Business Impact

If you operate chatbots in New York, ensure they do not impersonate licensed professionals or face potential liability.

Key Provisions

- The bill covers chatbots impersonating certain licensed professionals, but the specific types are unknown due to the lack of full bill text.
