HCR 94 requests a study to establish an artificial intelligence elective course in West Virginia high schools, focusing on practical instruction and hands-on learning.

Business Impact

If you operate in education in West Virginia, you must prepare to integrate AI curriculum by 2026 or risk falling behind in educational standards.

Key Provisions

- Study the establishment of an Artificial Intelligence Education Program in high schools.
- Assess current AI educational resources and identify gaps.
- Evaluate funding opportunities for the program.
- Analyze the impact of AI on industries and youth.
- Focus on practical instruction and hands-on learning opportunities.
- Provide recommendations for legislative measures and partnerships.
- Report findings and recommendations by the 2026 legislative session.
