Prohibits the publication of newspaper, magazine, or periodical which was wholly or partially produced or edited through the use of artificial intelligence without significant human oversight

## Summary

This New York bill seeks to regulate AI use in publishing by requiring significant human oversight, though not explicitly defined as editorial review.
