## Summary

This bill amends tax law concerning interest on taxes in cities with populations over one million, requiring a tax appeals tribunal determination within one year.

## Business Impact

If you publish books using generative AI in New York, you must disclose this use or face potential penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Amends tax law regarding interest on taxes in large cities.
- Requires a tax appeals tribunal determination within one year to prevent interest accrual.
