AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2; Title 4; Title 8; Title 38; Title 39 and Title 47, Chapter 18, relative to artificial intelligence.

Summary

The bill mandates Tennessee executive branch departments to create plans to prevent the misuse of artificial intelligence and report findings by January 1, 2025.

Business Impact

If you operate a business regulated by Tennessee state departments, you must prepare for AI misuse prevention plans by January 1, 2025, or face regulatory scrutiny.

Key Provisions

- Each executive branch department must develop a plan to prevent AI misuse.
- Plans must address the unlawful use of AI that interferes with departmental operations.
- Departments must report their plans and findings to the General Assembly by January 1, 2025.
