

# SB 2461 • Tennessee

State Government - As introduced, requires each department of the executive branch to develop a plan to prevent the malicious and unlawful use of artificial intelligence for the purpose of interfering with the operation of the department, its agencies and divisions, and persons and entities regulated by the respective department; requires each department to report its plan, findings, and recommendations to each member of the general assembly no later than January 1, 2025. - Amends TCA Title 2; Title 4; Title 8; Title 38; Title 39 and Title 47, Chapter 18.

## Summary

This bill mandates Tennessee's executive branch departments to create plans to prevent AI misuse and report findings by January 1, 2025.

## Business Impact

If you operate a department in Tennessee, you must develop an AI misuse prevention plan by January 1, 2025, or face potential legislative scrutiny.

## Key Provisions

- Each executive branch department must develop a plan to prevent AI misuse.
- Plans must address interference with department operations and regulated entities.
- Departments must report findings and recommendations to the General Assembly by January 1, 2025.
