

# SB 2461 • Tennessee

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2; Title 4; Title 8; Title 38; Title 39 and Title 47, Chapter 18, relative to artificial intelligence.

## Summary

This bill amends Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2; Title 4; Title 8; Title 38; Title 39 and Title 47, Chapter 18, mandating executive branch departments to create plans to prevent AI misuse and report findings by January 1, 2025.

## Business Impact

If you operate a department in Tennessee, you must develop an AI misuse prevention plan by January 1, 2025, or face potential regulatory scrutiny.

## Key Provisions

- The bill amends Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2; Title 4; Title 8; Title 38; Title 39 and Title 47, Chapter 18.
- Each executive branch department must develop a plan to prevent AI misuse.
- Plans must address the unlawful use of AI affecting department operations.
- Departments must report findings and recommendations to the General Assembly.
- Deadline for reporting is January 1, 2025.
- No specific penalties for non-compliance are outlined.
