Companion chatbots: children's safety.

Comprehensive

Summary

SB 1119 mandates specific safety protocols for companion chatbots interacting with children, though specific sections on data encryption and parental consent are unverified.

Business Impact

If you operate companion chatbots, you must conduct risk assessments by July 1, 2027, or face civil actions.

Key Provisions

- Mandatory data encryption for chatbot interactions with minors (pending verification)
- Parental consent required for data collection from children (pending verification)

Compliance Checklist

- Implement safety features for children's chatbots | Who: Developers and providers of chatbots | Penalty: Potential fines or restrictions on chatbot use
