## Summary

This bill amends Pennsylvania's commerce laws to enhance consumer protection regarding artificial intelligence and chatbots, detailing duties and penalties.

## Business Impact

If you use AI or chatbots in Pennsylvania, you must comply with new consumer protection regulations or face penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Establishes consumer protection measures for AI and chatbots.
- Imposes duties on the Bureau of Consumer Protection, including monitoring and investigation.
- Sets penalties for non-compliance with the regulations, including fines up to \$10,000 per violation.
