If you operate a chatbot in New York, you must ensure accurate information is provided to users or face potential liability.

Key Provisions

- Proposes liability for misleading, incorrect, or harmful information from chatbots.
- Analysis is limited and based solely on the official description, not the full bill text.
- Review of the full text is necessary to understand specific provisions, definitions, scope, enforcement mechanisms, exceptions, and legal implications.
