Summary

This bill imposes liability on proprietors of chatbots for damages caused by impersonating licensed professionals in New York.

Business Impact

If you use chatbots in your business, you must ensure they do not impersonate licensed professionals to avoid liability for damages.

Key Provisions

- Imposes liability on proprietors of chatbots for damages caused by impersonating licensed professionals.
- Specific conditions for liability and enforcement mechanisms are not confirmed without the full bill text.
