Establishing the Kansas community harmed by AI technology act, mandating user accounts and age verification for AI chatbot access, classifying users by age, requiring parental consent for minors, blocking explicit content, protecting age information confidentiality, monitoring for suicidal...

## Summary

The bill mandates user accounts, age verification, classification by age for AI chatbot access, requiring parental consent for minors, blocking explicit content, monitoring for suicidal ideation, informing users of AI interaction, protecting age information confidentiality, with compliance guidance by 2027, enforcement under consumer protection laws, and a safe harbor provision for compliant entities.

## Business Impact

If you operate AI chatbots in Kansas, you must implement user accounts and age verification by 2027 or face enforcement actions.

## Key Provisions

- Mandates user accounts and age verification for AI chatbot access.
- Requires parental consent for minors using AI chatbots.
- Classifies users by age.
- Blocks explicit content in AI interactions.
- Protects confidentiality of age information.
- Monitors for suicidal ideation among users.
- Informs users of AI interaction.
- Outlines enforcement under consumer protection laws.
