Prohibits the use of biometric surveillance technology by law enforcement; establishes the biometric surveillance regulation task force; and provides for the expiration and repeal of certain provisions

## Summary

This bill prohibits law enforcement from using facial recognition and other biometric surveillance technologies, establishes a task force with specific duties, and outlines conditions for the expiration and repeal of certain provisions.

## Business Impact

If you operate in law enforcement in New York, you must cease using biometric surveillance technology immediately or face legal consequences.

## Key Provisions

- Prohibits law enforcement from using facial recognition, iris scans, and other biometric surveillance technologies.
- Establishes a task force composed of experts to study and recommend regulations on biometric technology.
- Specifies that provisions related to temporary bans on specific technologies will expire and be repealed upon the establishment of permanent regulations by the task force.
