Summary

Requires AI training for students, faculty, and staff in California public colleges, with intent for future AI legislation.

Business Impact

If you provide AI tools in CA colleges, you must offer training or face compliance issues.

Key Provisions

- Training on AI products required for California Community Colleges and California State University.
- University of California is requested to provide similar training.
- Training must include AI usage policies and privacy disclosures.
- Legislative intent to enact future AI-related legislation in postsecondary education.
