Summary

AB2392's framework for GenAI in public colleges is speculative, based on the title and description, pending full bill text confirmation.

Business Impact

If you operate a public college in California, you must develop AI procurement standards and training by January 1, 2028, or face legislative scrutiny.

Key Provisions

- Potential development of procurement standards for GenAI systems, pending confirmation.
- Possible mandate for training programs for staff and faculty on GenAI systems, pending confirmation.
