Summary

AB 2412 addresses public communications by state agencies, focusing on artificial intelligence. Specific details are pending the release of the full bill text.

Business Impact

If you operate a state agency using GenAI for public communications, you must include disclaimers by implementation date or face compliance issues.

Key Provisions

- The full bill text is needed to determine if state agencies may need to include disclaimers in public communications regarding artificial intelligence.
- Specific requirements and affected agencies will be confirmed with the full bill text.

Compliance Checklist

- Include disclaimers in all public communications generated by GenAI | Who: State agencies and departments | Penalty: Potential scrutiny and challenges regarding communication practices
- Provide information on how to contact a human employee | Who: State agencies and departments | Penalty: Potential scrutiny and challenges regarding communication practices
