Last Action (Aug 29, 2025): August 29 hearing: Held in committee and under submission.

Summary

Requires the CA Attorney General to develop an AI expertise program in collaboration with state agencies and technical experts, reporting on AI law and policy by July 1, 2027.

Business Impact

If you develop AI in California, expect increased oversight and reporting requirements by July 2027.

Key Provisions

- Establish a program to build AI expertise within the Department of Justice.
- Designate a team responsible for AI-related legal and policy issues.
- Recruit or train staff with AI knowledge.
- Collaborate with academic, civil rights organizations, state agencies, and technical experts.
- Submit an annual report to the Legislature on AI developments.
