Summary

SB69 requires the California Attorney General to establish a program to enhance expertise in artificial intelligence and report on its developments annually.

Business Impact

If you operate in California and use AI, you must stay informed about regulatory developments and potential compliance requirements by 2027.

Key Provisions

- Establishes a program within the Attorney General's office to build AI expertise.
- Mandates annual public reporting on AI developments and recommendations for oversight.

- Establish an internal program for AI expertise | Who: California Attorney General's office | Penalty: Potential lack of compliance with state oversight requirements
- Submit annual public reports on AI developments | Who: California Attorney General's office | Penalty: Failure to report may hinder regulatory compliance and oversight
