Business Impact

If you use AI to detect firearms in public, you must cease by Oct 1, 2025, or face misdemeanor charges.

- Prohibition of AI use to detect firearms in public areas (Section 790.34(1))
- First-degree misdemeanor penalties for violations (Section 790.34(2))
- Exceptions require verification (Section 790.34(3))
