Summary

Mandates AI use for school transport routes within three years after availability, requires transportation for K-12 students living over one mile from school, and revises hazardous walking conditions.

Business Impact

If you use AI for school transport, implement it within 3 years or face a 15% funding cut.

Key Provisions

- Requires transportation for K-12 students living more than 1 mile from school (s. 1006.21(3)(a))
- Mandates AI use for optimizing transport routes within three years after availability (s. 1006.21(3)(e))
- Requires school bus stops within 1,000 feet of student's home (s. 1006.21(3)(c))
- Revises criteria for hazardous walking conditions and mandates inspections within 72 hours of a request (s. 1006.23(2))
- Requires parental consent for student transportation (s. 1002.20(22)(c))

- Provide transportation for students living over 1 mile from school | Who: District school boards
- Obtain parental consent for student transportation | Who: School districts
