Summary

This bill mandates a survey of the Illinois Administrative Code to assess restrictions on the private sector and local governments, utilizing AI for analysis.

Business Impact

If you operate a business in Illinois, you must be prepared for potential changes in regulations based on the Auditor General's report within 2 years.

Key Provisions

- Auditor General to survey the Illinois Administrative Code for mandates on private sector and local governments.
- Allows use of artificial intelligence in the survey process.
- State agencies must submit follow-up reports within 9 months of the Auditor General's report.
- Joint Committee on Administrative Rules to supervise and report on compliance.
- Agencies must reduce mandates to 250,000 or 80% of the original amount, whichever is lesser, within 2 years.
- Final report on compliance to be submitted by the Joint Committee after implementation.

Compliance Checklist

- Conduct a survey of mandates and restrictions as per the Auditor General's report. | Who: Auditor General | Penalty: Non-compliance may lead to regulatory scrutiny.
- Submit follow-up reports acknowledging findings. | Who: Each State agency | Penalty: Potential oversight by the Joint Committee.
- Adopt, amend, or repeal rules to reduce mandates. | Who: Each State agency | Penalty: Failure to comply may result in continued regulatory burdens.
