### Summary

Amends the Biometric Information Privacy Act to exempt companies testing autonomous vehicles from its provisions.

### Business Impact

If you conduct testing of autonomous vehicles in Illinois, you are exempt from certain biometric privacy regulations.

### Key Provisions

- Exempts companies testing autonomous vehicles from BIPA provisions.
- Applies to companies registered with the Department of Transportation.
