Summary

SB 813 establishes the California AI Standards and Safety Commission, with specific roles and responsibilities to be confirmed upon release of the full bill text.

Business Impact

If you operate in California and use AI, you must engage an independent verification organization by January 1, 2025, or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- The California AI Standards and Safety Commission is established, with specific roles to be confirmed.
- The role of independent verification organizations in assessing compliance with AI safety standards is pending confirmation from the full bill text.
