### Summary

The bill allows the State Board of Education to provide guidance on workforce development curricula focused on AI and quantum computing for schools.

### Business Impact

If you operate a school in Illinois, you must adopt new technology curricula on AI and quantum computing to prepare students for future jobs.

### Key Provisions

- State Board of Education may provide guidance on workforce development curricula.
- Focus on teaching artificial intelligence, quantum computing, and other technologies.
- Comprehensive review of technology curricula from other states required.
- Stakeholder meetings and public comments will inform the guidance.
- Curriculum aims to prepare students for future job competencies.
