## FRAUD-ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE

Last Action (Mar 27, 2026): Rule 19(a) / Re-referred to Rules Committee

## Summary

This bill requires operators of generative AI systems in Illinois to display user warnings about the limitations of such systems, but does not specify a compliance deadline. Note: The full bill text is not available, which may limit this analysis.

## Business Impact

If you operate a generative AI system in Illinois, you must display a user warning daily or face penalties for each violation.

## Key Provisions

- Operators of generative AI systems must display user warnings about limitations.
- Each day without the warning is a separate violation.
- Violations are considered unlawful practices under the Consumer Fraud Act.

## Compliance Checklist

- Display a conspicuous warning on the user interface of the generative AI system. | Who: Owners, licensees, or operators of generative AI systems. | Penalty: Each day without the warning is a separate violation.
