Last Action (Mar 27, 2026): Rule 19(a) / Re-referred to Rules Committee

Summary

This bill mandates that generative AI systems display a warning about their limitations on their user interface.

Business Impact

If you operate a generative AI system in Illinois, you must display a warning about its limitations or face daily penalties.

Key Provisions

- Generative AI systems must display a conspicuous warning about their limitations.
- Each day without the required warning is a separate violation.
- Violations are considered unlawful practices under the Consumer Fraud Act.
- Applies to owners, licensees, or operators of generative AI systems.

Compliance Checklist

- Display a warning about the limitations of your generative AI system. | Who: Owners, licensees, or operators of generative AI systems. | Penalty: Each day without the warning is a separate violation.
